



PARENTS' CODE OF ETHICS

Please remember that travel basketball is competitive, and all athletes will not receive equal playing time. Parents are welcome to all games (admission charges may apply). Parents should be the example to students as models of sportsmanship. Therefore, parents should not argue with officials, or referees during or after a game.

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for children participating in youth sports by following this Parent's Code of Ethics:

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, or other amateur youth sporting event.

I will place the emotional and physical well-being of children ahead of my personal desire to win

I will require that coaches be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach and that the coach upholds a Coaches' Code of Ethics

I will support coaches and officials working with children in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all involved

I will demand a sports environment for all participants that is safe, healthy, and free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and will refrain from their uses at all youth sports events

I will do my best to make youth sports fun for my child and others

I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability

I fully support a policy of "ZERO TOLERANCE" to violence, abusive language, and such matters detrimental to all players, participants, and patrons

I will not approach the scores table for any reason. If I have an issue, I will contact the league coordinator.
