



## PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

Please remember that travel basketball is competitive, and all athletes will not receive equal playing time. Players will be required to attend all scheduled practices. If a player misses practice, the player could miss game time unless a valid excuse is received from the parent. Florida All-Stars requires good sportsmanship from its players. Improper conduct on or off the court may result in game suspension or removal from the team. Players must maintain an overall "C" average while participating in the Florida All-Stars program. If a student is failing a subject, they may not be allowed to participate until the subject is brought up to a passing grade.

The following Code of Conduct applies to all players involved in basketball competitions through the Florida All-Stars, LLC. Failure to abide by the Code will result in a breach of the Players' Code of Ethics.

I will respect myself, staff, coaches, equipment, and others when competing in the Florida All-Stars Basketball Program

I will exhibit good sportsmanship when competing regardless of the outcome

I will agree to let my coach resolve ALL differences with scores table, officials or referees

I agree to dress according to specific rules regarding no jewelry, and jerseys tucked in

I agree to model appropriate behavior, be a role model for my teammates as well as for my opponents and resolve all disagreements in a non-violent manner

I agree to line up at the conclusion of each competition and greet my opponent regardless of the outcome
